



# Hungary

In IMPACT 44, just two years ago, we first reported the early activities of Dianetics moving into Hungary. At that time there were two missions in the country. Since then, great expansion has occurred. There are now four new missions in addition to the original two in Budapest.

The main mission in Budapest now has 55 staff. It sells 100-300 books and delivers 100 hours of auditing a week.

The Paks mission delivers basic Dianetics and Scientology services. Of its 20 part time staff, 14 are trained in Book One auditing.

Pecs Mission has 24 staff, two auditor trainees in Munich org and a trained supervisor. This mission delivers courses and Book One auditing.

Gyor Mission has 9 staff with two trainees at Munich org.

Tatabania Mission has 13 staff and is disseminating heavily.

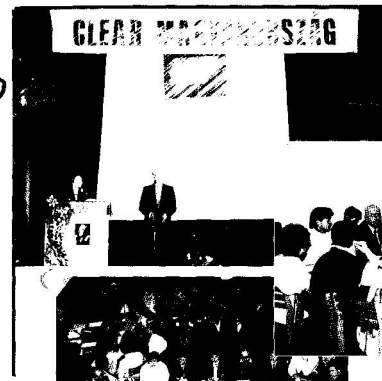
The Szolnok mission just recently became licensed and has 20 people disseminating.

Largely responsible for this burgeoning expansion is this Hamburg Organization Deputy Executive Director for Expansion, Holger Hackenjos, who is a New OT VIII and a Lifetime Member of the IAS.

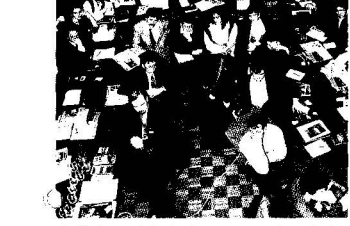
The Executive Director of the Munich Organization, Nina Voigt, Patron of the Association, has also greatly contributed to this expansion. Many staff from these missions have been sent to Munich to be trained there.

Such was the expansion, a Clear Hungary Congress was

held recently in Budapest to get the different sectors in communication with each other, coordinated and starting more activities to clear Hungary. As well as Nina from Munich and Holger from Hamburg, representatives from Scientology Missions International, Association for Better Living and Education, World Institute of Scientology Enterprises and Citizens Commission on Human Rights and the Captain of the Advanced Organization Saint Hill Europe attended the congress. There were 450 people there and they were briefed about the full scope of Scientology and Dianetics with different seminars and briefings held by each sector. Plans for future expansion were formulated and coordinated including making

recruited for Applied Scholastics and he will open a National training center for teachers, business people and students. His first business training program started in February.

Up to now there has been no Narconon activity in Hungary. At the congress five people were recruited to start a Narconon.

A Criminon group for Hungary was started with two police officers, one of whom has worked in the police department for 20 years and has the rank of city captain. He is arranging the printing of *The Way To Happiness* booklet with the extension course for distribution in prisons.

With all of the sectors opening up in Hungary, further expansion there is inevitable.

the Budapest Mission into a Class V org.

At the Mission Holders briefing, four new licenses were signed for yet more missions.

A Clear Hungary Committee was formed to maintain the coordination and mutual assistance that the congress provided.

Two hundred participants, including several teachers, attended a briefing on LRH

study tech given by Boris Levitsky (IAS Freedom Medal Winner). The teachers immediately wanted to know how they could implement the tech in their schools and others wanted to start an Applied Scholastics group. In fact there was an enormous reach to reform the educational system in Hungary by using the study technology of LRH. An Executive Director was

Dianetics first appeared in Greece in the early sixties. In the early 1980s a group was formed that first became a city office and then, in 1986, Athens Mission. Suddenly, over the past year, a real boom has occurred in Athens.

This time last year, Athens Mission was producing about 60 hours of auditing a week. Now it is producing 175 per week and getting more than 20 people per week starting a service on The Bridge.

This time last year they had 12 staff. Now they have 24

including a Class V Graduate Auditor, two Class IV Auditors and a Book One Auditor. Athens Mission has been sending people to Flag for training and a fully trained supervisor has just returned. The mission also gets many people to sign up for Free Six month memberships in the IAS, and Elcna Czibalmos, Lifetime Member and a mission executive, makes people into full members of the IAS - more than ever before since she attended the IAS convention in the UK last

October with the Mission Holder, Michel Czibalmos. Michel is a Lifetime Member, a Class V Graduate Auditor and C/S and Clear. He has been the mission holder for Athens Mission for 6 years. Asked about the sudden expansion in the past year, Michel replied, "It was mainly the decision to expand and turn the Mission into a Class V organization."

Field Staff Members in the last two years, Katerina and Maria Paretzougou and Sotira Spinou. Maria has now joined staff and is the Public Executive Secretary of the mission.

WISE groups have been established around the mission and a WISE college is planned for Athens in the near future.

Each week the mission runs seminars on different subjects. The OCA personality test is used to disseminate and sell LRH books.

The Athens mission has helped disseminate in Cyprus and a mission is forming there with a staff member in training at Flag to be a supervisor. The Athens

mission is also opening a mission in Corinth (see map).

A group of LRH Personal Public Relations Officers has been formed with 13 people and the first thing they are doing is locating people who met with LRH when he was in Greece in 1969. An event is planned in Corfu with the intention of starting a mission there, so that those who knew LRH can have the benefit of his technology.

Michel Czibalmos came into Scientology nine years ago in France. "The reason I am in Greece," he says, "is a pretty long story. Suffice it to say that I like adventure and I came here with the purpose of expanding Scientology in this country."



The countries we have looked at so far in this article have had for some years, an established Dianetics or Scientology activity. But how does it start? How does a country without any Dianetics or Scientology activity actually get going?

In 1986, the Scientology Missions International Expansion Office was established at Flag to start pushing out the perimeters of Scientology, opening missions in far away places. The International Association of Scientologists gave several grants to enable the first Scientology missionaries to go to India, Ghana, Nigeria,

Indonesia and many other countries.

Over the years, a successful pattern of action developed for opening up a new area to Dianetics and Scientology. The first of these actions is to send a missionary to the area to lecture or hold seminars. A missionary can then help the interested people form a group.

One such missionary is Evelyn Clark, Lifetime Member, New OT VIII and a Class VI Auditor. Last year she visited Egypt.

When she set off for Alexandria in July last year, her contact was Dr. Ali Mehilba, a physician, who,

about three years ago started to search for answers and came across the book Dianetics. He wrote to the Scientology Missions International Expansion Office at Flag asking for some assistance.

When Evelyn arrived, she contacted Dr. Mehilba and gave him data about Dianetics and answered his questions. He gathered some of his professional friends so that Evelyn could deliver

introductory instruction in Dianetics, using the Dianetics Picture Book and the Dianetics video. The group learned Dianetics procedures and drilled them. One of the doctors, with Dr. Mehilba's help, translated some of the materials and the Dianetics procedures into Arabic, so that people could audit in their own language. Thus the group began co-auditing.

When a missionary leaves, the Scientology Missions

International Expansion Office takes over and keeps in communication with the groups of people auditing Dianetics.

Scientology missionaries don't just deal with Dianetics in a new area. They may also introduce study technology or Narconon drug rehabilitation technology or even LRH administration technology. Each different area has its own particular reality. China, for instance

was first introduced to the works of LRH through study technology and business seminars.

While Evelyn was in Egypt, she met the legal advisor for the Arab Bureau of Education in the Gulf, based in Saudi Arabia. Any change, new curriculum, program or addition to the existing education system has to be approved by that Bureau. Evelyn used this opportunity to disseminate the benefits of LRH study technology and proposed a pilot project be conducted in two schools. He agreed, suggesting two universities where this could be done. The pilot will be implemented later this year.

Thus another country will soon have the hope offered by LRH's technology.

Ms. Sherry Murphy, a Lifetime Member and Sponsor of the Association, is the senior Church of Scientology International executive in charge of field activities - Fields Executive International. A graduate of the Organization Executive Course and the Flag Executive Briefing Course, she is responsible for the entire Scientology field, including Field Staff Members, groups, field auditors, Scientology Missions International, World Institute of Scientology Enterprises and every other type of field activity.

Ms. Murphy's job is to expand field activities internationally by getting every Scientologist actively involved in the dissemination and use of LRH technology. IAS members are therefore very important to her, since it is you who are primarily doing this and want to do more.

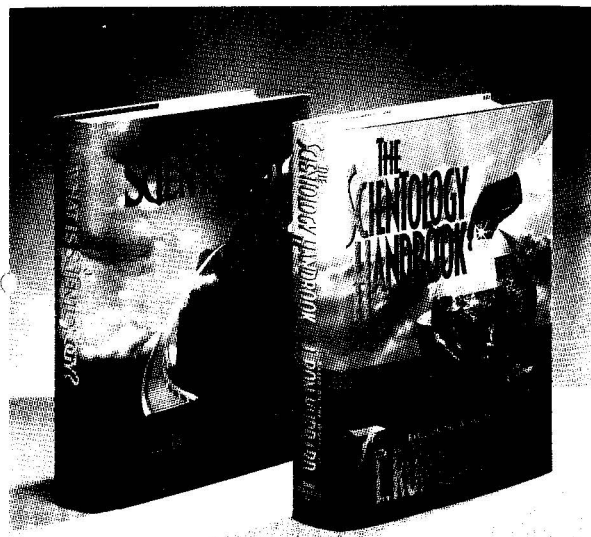

**IMPACT:** *The release in five languages of The Scientology Handbook with its 19 booklets is an enormous achievement. What is the purpose of releasing this book at this time?*

**MS. MURPHY:** This was not just the release of another book - it was also the beginning of a crusade to build a better world. With this book we have the means to spread Scientology

technology throughout society at a rapid rate. The way we can do this is to get hundreds of thousands of Volunteer Ministers operating in their communities so the world does become a better place to live in. The Volunteer Ministers program provides spiritual help and support on a very wide basis in all spheres of society. *The Scientology Handbook* provides the materials with

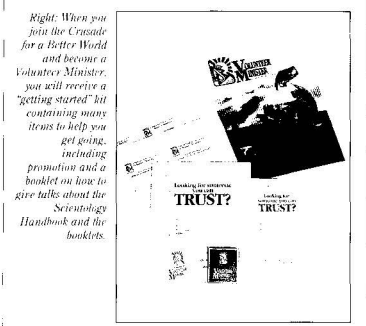

neighborhood or community.

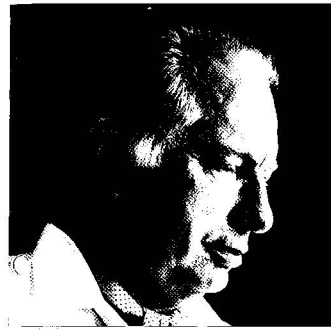
**IMPACT:** *Tell us more about the Volunteer Ministers Program.*
