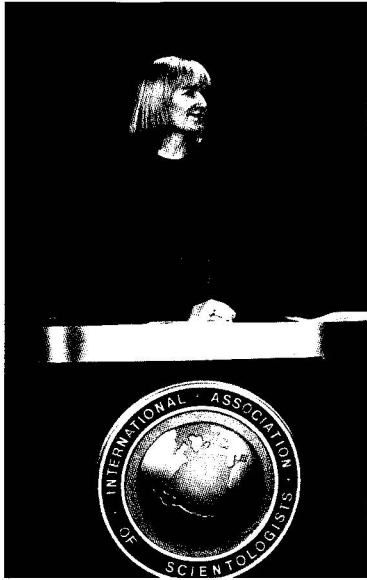

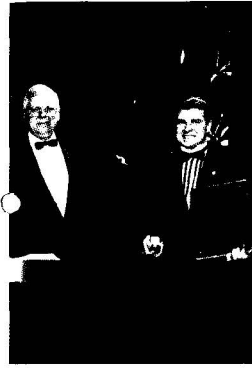
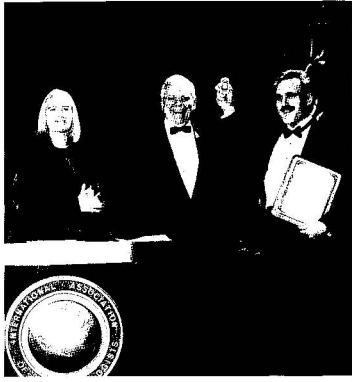

IAS GRANT FUNDS EXPOSURE OF PSYCHIATRY'S INVOLVEMENT IN BOSNIAN WAR

For almost two and a half years now the former Yugoslavia has been the site of indescribable human rights atrocities. The world has watched in horror through extensive media coverage, while various government leaders have debated whether or not to intervene. Despite overwhelming evidence of frightening similarities to the Nazi holocaust of World War II, very little effective action has been taken by the governments of the world to either stop the war or to intercede on behalf of its victims, now numbering in the hundreds of thousands.

One Scientologist, Paul Rood of the Netherlands, an IAS Freedom Medal Winner, decided to take action – first to increase the exposure of psychiatry's part in creating and continuing this war, and then to elicit support for the Church of Scientology's and the Citizen's Commission on Human Rights' actions to put an end to the madness.

An IAS grant was provided so that Paul Rood, along with a support team of four other Scientologists, could protest the atrocities of the Bosnian war and expose the fact that the real engineers of the war and its barbarisms are psychiatrists; and that these

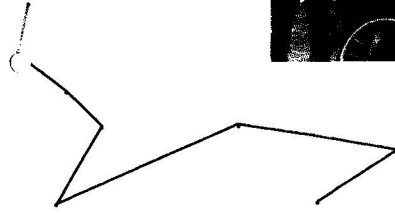
criminals have been inflaming their people into irrational racial hatred and using nazi-psych "ethnic cleansing" theories to justify their actions.

Beginning in Amsterdam, Holland on September 13, 1993, Paul and his team visited 12 key European cities, starting in Amsterdam, Holland and finishing the crusade in Zagreb, the capital of war-torn Croatia.

In each city en route Paul was received by mayors and their staff, senators, members

of the European Parliament, various politicians, newspaper and television reporters and religious leaders. City by city, these meetings resulted in positive press, much of it accurately reporting the information he provided, which emphatically promoted the involvement of psychiatry in this terrible war.

The cities visited by Paul and his team were: The Hague and Antwerp in Holland; Brussels in Belgium,

Luxembourg; Strasbourg in France; Geneva in Switzerland; Passau in Germany; Linz and Vienna in Austria; Bratislava in Slovakia; Budapest in Hungary; Zagreb in Croatia.

Throughout his trip, Paul was received with great respect for what he was doing. In Luxembourg, Paul was awarded the "Seal of the City." In Bratislava and Vienna, he was also awarded medals. These awards were

given to express the full support of those cities for his actions. Several cities aired TV interviews with Paul.

The tour culminated in Zagreb, Croatia. Here an excellent television interview was done on the national TV station and aired on prime-time, widely disseminating the facts about psychiatry causing this war.

The following is a translation of one of the many newspaper articles that

appeared throughout Paul's Crusade. This one is from Croatia itself.

"Paul Rood from the Netherlands uses an unusual method to point out the causes of the war in Croatia to European public...."

"Member of the Church of Scientology of the Netherlands, Paul Rood, rode his bicycle 1,500 kilometers from Amsterdam to Zagreb to warn European public about psychiatric abuses...."

"We have a lot of documented materials that show the use of psychiatry as a tool for achieving specific goals. After we had proved the importance of the role of psychiatry in the war in ex-Yugoslavia, we started more thorough research," says

Rood. The result is a publication called 'War in ex-Yugoslavia' in which the roles of Dr. Jovan Raskovich and his student Radovan Karadzic were analyzed in relation to the war in Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina.

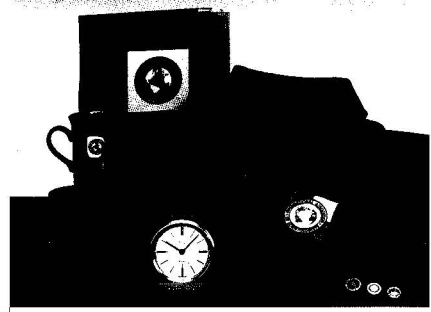
"In the publication the

misuse of psychiatry in spreading 'Great Serbian' racist ideas is thoroughly explained as well as some things that were not known to the broad public in the rest of Europe - for example, the fact that the Serbian president Slobodan Milosevich was under the psychiatric treatment of Radovan Karadzic. Further, the publication analyzes racist statements about Croations and Muslims which were promoted for the first time in Raskovich's book 'A Mad Country.'

"During his trip, Rood distributed copies of the publication (War in ex-Yugoslavia) to all of the politicians he could find. The bicycle trip is one of the first

actions through which the Citizens Commission on Human Rights, established by the Church of Scientology, is attempting to point out violations of human rights caused by psychiatric abuses."

The overall products of this IAS-funded project are outstanding. Many key opinion leaders favorably received Paul's message in cities across Europe and understood psychiatry's role in the war in former Yugoslavia. Valuable allies were created for the Church of Scientology. The light of truth has been turned on psychiatric involvement in this terrible war. The contributions of IAS members made this action possible.
